



COMMITMENT

Our Gender Equality Commitment promotes and models gender equality throughout Moreland. Gender equality means the equality of rights, opportunities and responsibilities for people of all genders. It means all genders should have the same access to wellbeing, freedom of choice and safety.



Moreland City Council

Moreland Council accepts its leadership role in the community. We are committed to providing services that are inclusive, culturally safe and respectful for all gender, sexual and cultural identities.

We acknowledge existing systematic gender inequality and that there is no 'one size fits all' approach to helping guide culture change.

This framework has been developed in partnership with the community and has created a vision, principles, commitments and strategies to guide both Council's and community partners' actions.



THIS COMMITMENT

recognises that gender is non-binary. It acknowledges that women, men and gender diverse or non-binary people experience gender inequality differently and acknowledges and affirms all terms that people choose to use for themselves.

VISION

The Moreland Gender Equality Commitment asks that we all work together towards creating a future where all gender identities can thrive. We know there's work to do, so that people of all gender identities:

- Feel able to exist openly and safely in Moreland
- Have equal access to housing, employment, education, public space, recreation and sport
- Along with representation at all levels of decision making, and at all intersections of identity.

THE COMMITMENT

1 equal visibility, access to self-representation and leadership opportunities

2 all genders can access public space, sports and recreation and feel safe

3 equal pay for equal work

4 access to safe and affordable housing

5 equal access to formal and community education

6 all genders are empowered to support the Gender Equality Commitment

7 accountability, evaluation and reporting



IMPLEMENTATION

The Gender Equality Commitment will guide actions and practices across Moreland Council – throughout all levels of the organisation and through the community – with a focus on intersectionality and identified priority groups from the Moreland Human Rights Policy 2016-2026. These include women, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities, migrant and refugee communities, people with disability, LBGTIQA+ communities.

The resources required to implement the Moreland Gender Equality Commitment are detailed in joint biennial action plans that are being developed with input from business units across Council and community partners.



DEFINITIONS

Gender: The socially-constructed differences between men and women, which are separate from ‘sex’, which refers to their biological differences. *When we refer to ‘women’ or ‘men’ we include female- or male- identifying people, including transgender, cisgender and others who identify themselves within the spectrum of the gender identity of female or male.*

Gender diverse / non-binary people: An umbrella term used to describe all those whose gender identity may not correlate with their biological sex assigned at birth.

Gender equality: means equality of rights, opportunities, responsibilities and outcomes between people of different genders.
