DESIGN STATEMENT

Spade edging is a cost-effective solution for providing a neat edge between lawn and garden bed, cut on an angle using a spade.

Other edging materials can be provided where a fixed edge is needed (such as using composite, timber or steel edging). However, spade edging is more useful where tighter curves are required and it facilitates mowing by maintenance teams.

APPLICABLE LOCATION

Merri-bek open space including conservation areas, parks, playspaces and reserves.

Edging material to be confirmed with relevant council units.

Angled spade cut to form spade edge. Refer detail.

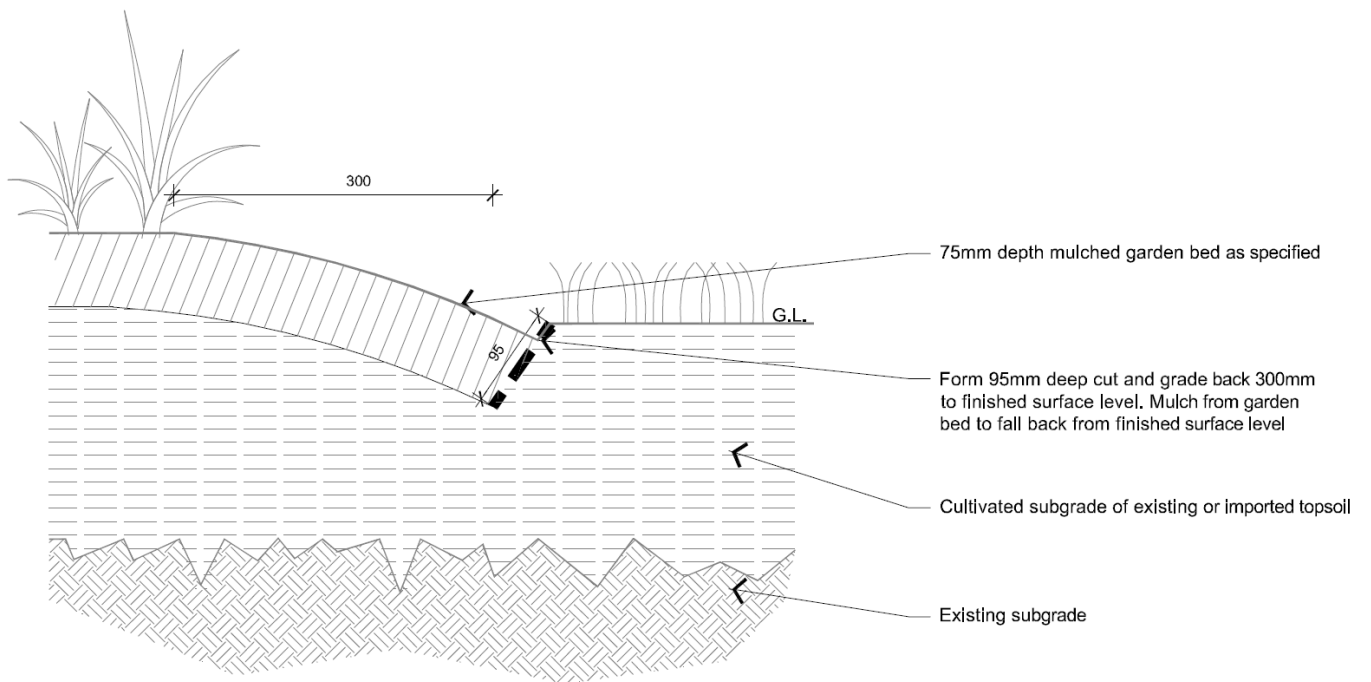
