

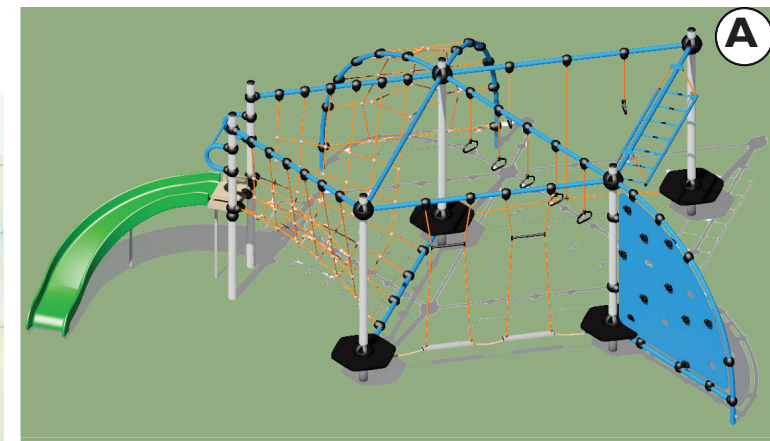
Final Concept Design for Martin Reserve

Council is planning to upgrade Martin Reserve in Domain Street, Hadfield, with funding allocated in the 2020-2021 budget. The proposed upgrade focuses on the playspace and open space areas, excluding the sports area.

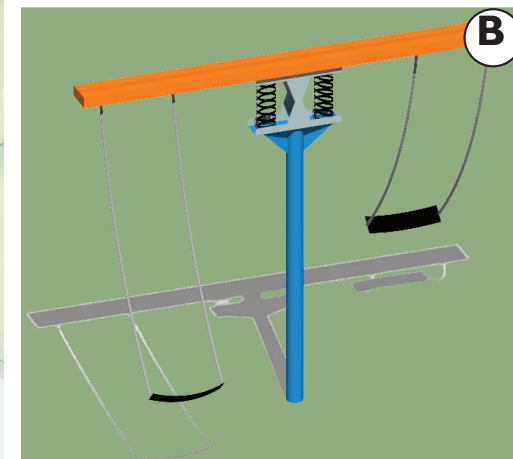
Proposed works include:

- A gathering space with BBQ, picnic setting, platform seat, and accessible drinking fountain with dog bowl
- Upgraded playspace with new equipment including dynamic swing, nest swing, climbing unit with slide and climbing wall, junior cubby house with slide, dynamic see-saw and log balancing structure
- Replacement of cyclone fencing along Epping Street with park fencing & gate access to the playspace
- Connecting paths from Epping Street via the playspace to the reserve car park and to the gathering space (also for scooter play)
- Backed seat, platform seat & log edging (for informal seating/play) in the playspace
- Rail fencing removed from the south of the playspace in favour of a curved garden bed with feature trees & shrubs
- Additional trees and shrubs on all sides of the playspace.

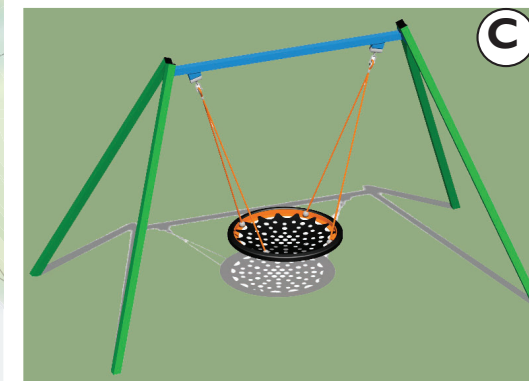
Exercise equipment stations are also proposed with a circuit path around the oval, as a separate stage of works.



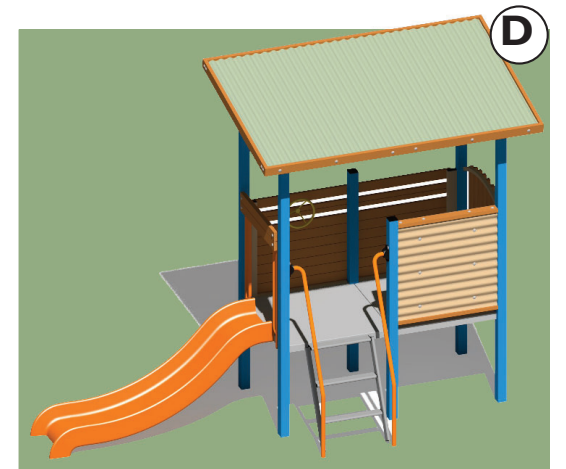
Senior Climbing unit with slide



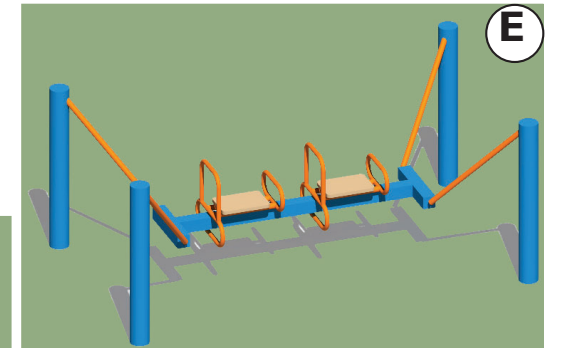
Dynamic Double Swing



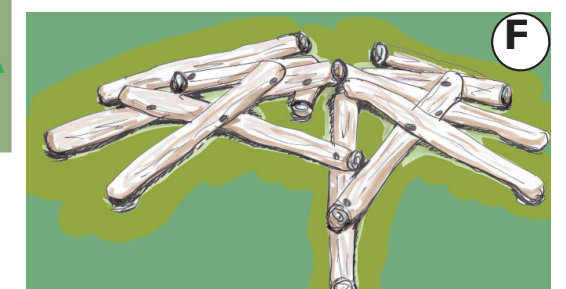
Nest Swing
