The playground at Oak Park Reserve will be upgraded this year as part of the Moreland Play Strategy 2016-20.


This playground upgrade proposes a blend of contemporary play equipment, recycled materials and nature play elements in colours and shapes to compliment the adjacent sporting complex and provide an inviting play experience.

Rocks, logs, steppers and pavers for balancing, standing and sitting have been placed to create challenge and playful circuits for children. Picnic tables and a variety of different seating arrangements within and around the playspace will provide restful opportunities for both users and carers of all ages.

These elements will activate the space and create more variety of play experiences. The new native plantings will also increase shade and amenity to this location surrounded by sports facilities.
